I. Call to order

Mayor Andrus called the meeting to order at 6:00 P.M.

II. Public Comments

City Manager Joel Dye read comments received from the Clerk's Office from Austin Kruetz. Comments included remarks concerning the City of Allegan usage of public property. City Clerk Christopher Tapper read comments received Charles Tripp regarding Resolution 21.06 City of Election Cycle. Mr. Tripp voiced his approval of the resolution.

III. Discussion regarding Motor Vehicle Pool

Dye presented to the Council a discussion presentation from Enterprise Fleet Management. The presentation outlined the City of Allegan Motor Pool Division. The report outlined the current condition of the City's vehicle fleet along with the potential improvements the City would be eligible for with Enterprise Fleet Management.

A general discussion ensued regarding the presentation. The City of Allegan current has 20 light duty vehicles. These vehicles included police vehicles, DPW pick-up trucks and the Water Utilities trucks. The current inventory of vehicles are driven until the are of no value. This process has led to poor equipment, higher maintenance cost, frustration among staff, lower resale value and possibly less than optimized worker output.

Mayor Andrus reviewed the Council meeting agenda for April 12, 2021. Mayor Andrus noted from staff of the amendment received to include agenda item Intergovernmental Agreement between the City of Allegan and Allegan District Library.
